



Privacy Policy for Joshua Tarrant Trust

Overview

The General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) give individuals more control over how their personal data is used and places certain obligations on businesses that process the information belonging to those individuals.

This privacy policy tells you how Joshua Tarrant Trust uses your personal data when you visit our website, order our products and/or interact with us by phone, email or social media. It also tells you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

Personal data which we collect about you

Personal data or information means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data). We collect a variety of information about you and visitors to the Joshua Tarrant Trust website. This personal data includes the following:

- Your first and last names.
- Your internet protocol (IP) address.
- Your billing addresses.
- Your delivery addresses.
- Email address and telephone numbers.
- An encrypted version of your login/password (for account holders).
- Details about payments and products you have ordered from us.
- Usage data about how you use our website (see 'Cookies' below).
- Your preferences in receiving communications/direct marketing.

Financial Data: Please note we **do not** have access to your payment card details.

How is your personal data collected?

You may give us personal data by browsing on our website; placing an order for our products; setting up a Joshua Tarrant Trust account; contacting us directly via our online contact form, through the post, by phone, email or by communicating with us on social media.



How we use your personal data.

We use your data mainly to process any orders you make with Joshua Tarrant Trust. We may also use it to contact you with any queries we have about an order or to reply to any direct communications you make to us. We do not currently use your data for direct marketing purposes, except where we have your express permission to use your contact details for this purpose, we will inform you if this changes at any point in the future.

You have a right at any time to change your mind and opt out. The easiest way to do this is to let us know at denise@joshuatarranttrust.org.uk

The legal basis we rely on to process personal data.

GDPR says that we can use and share personal data only where we have a proper reason to do so. Our lawful basis for processing is:

- Contract - your personal information is processed in order to fulfil a contractual arrangement e.g. in order to send you your order.
- Consent - where you agree to us using your information in this way e.g. for sending you emails about new information or developments.

Cookies

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard internet log information and visitor behaviour information. This is used to track use of our website and can be used to compile statistical information on website activity. For further information visit www.aboutcookies.org or www.allaboutcookies.org.

You can set your browser not to accept cookies and the above websites tell you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases some of our website features may not function as a result.



Disclosures of your personal data

We never share your personal details with, or sell them, to any third parties. You will always be informed if this changes and given the option to opt out. We do receive some personal details from some specific third parties, namely PayPal, in order to process your orders. Data security

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal data from being used in an unauthorised way. In addition, we limit access to your personal data to those who need to know. They will only process your personal data for the purposes laid out in this privacy policy and subject to a duty of confidentiality.

We have put in place procedures to deal with any suspected personal data breach and will notify you and any applicable regulator of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

Third-party links

Our website includes links to third-party websites and applications (for example, Facebook). Clicking on those links may allow third parties to collect or share your data. We do not control these third-party websites and are not responsible for their privacy statements. We encourage you to read the privacy policy of each website you visit.



Data retention

We will only keep your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. By law we must keep basic information about our customers for six years after they stop being customers for tax purposes.

Your legal rights

You have the following rights under data protection laws in relation to your personal data:

- The right to be informed - about how we use your personal data.
- The right of access - to request a copy of the personal data we hold about you.
- The right to rectification - to make us correct personal data about you that may be incomplete or inaccurate.
- The right to erasure ('to be forgotten') - you may ask us to delete the personal data we have about you (unless there's an overriding legal reason not to).
- The right to restrict processing - to ask us to suspend processing personal data.
- The right to data portability - a right for you to ask us for a copy of your personal data in a common format.
- The right to object - to us processing your personal data (for example, for direct marketing).
- Rights in relation to automated decision making and profiling - for us to be transparent about any profiling we do, or any automated decision making.
